Included are Riverbank, Shipshead Farm, Legacy, Gross Coate Farm, Ashby, William Mason Shehan House, and the Third Haven Friends Meeting House – all in Easton. The Tour will also cover a stop at the award-winning Talbot Historical Society Garden, lovingly maintained by the Talbot County Garden Club. Proceeds will help restore Joseph's Cottage, a late 18th Century wooden dwelling on the Historical Society grounds.
